It is with great pleasure that I inform you we are once again offering the *On-Course to NMCC Scholarship* for the 2018-2019 academic year. These scholarships (totaling some \$15,000) will be awarded to deserving, qualified students who have benefited from *any* early college experience (preference given to students participating in an On-Course program with NMCC) who is accepted and enrolls into an associate degree program at the College.

Scholarships range between \$250 and \$1,500.

The students, selected by NMCC's scholarship committee, must meet **one** of the following criteria:

- Has successfully completed (C or higher) one or more graded early college course(s): Dual credit, HS Aspirations, Early College for ME; *or*
- Successfully completed one or more courses at a Maine CTE center.

Recipients must:

- Receive unconditional acceptance into an associate degree level academic program at the College; *and*,
- Complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA); *and*,
- Attend NMCC the year immediately following HS graduation.

To Apply:

- Apply for admission at NMCC; *and*,
- Send Official College transcript (if course not taken with NMCC); *and*,
- Send the completed *On-Course to NMCC Scholarship* application along with two (2) personal references (one from a HS/CTE instructor or administrator) to: Shannon Cook, On-Course for College Coordinator, NMCC, 33 Edgemont Drive, Presque Isle, ME 04769.
